Wiltshire

Explore the heart of crop circle country accompanied by an author and expert dowser. Visit famous collections of standing stones, Europe's largest man made mound, a 5,000 year old chambered tomb and a visit to the best Bronze Age archaeology collection in Britain. The famous Cathedral which boasts Britain's tallest spire and home of the Magna Carta. Lunch at 'Crop Circle Central' with the opportunity to talk to the locals, and an exclusive visit at dawn to Stonehenge.

Somerset

The Isle of Avalon, villages built of flint and thatch. and rolling limestone hills. Visit the gravesite of Arthur, drink from the famous Chalice Well Spring and learn the fate of the holy chalice from the Last Supper. Glastonbury Tor at dusk, a Roman Hill Fort and a medieval city which dates back to pre-Roman times with bubbling springs and a beautiful English Cathedral.

Devon & Cornwall

Explore important megalithic sites of enigmatic standing stones, lovely circles and dolmens, or quoits as they are known. Visit a landmark that lies on one of Britain's most prominent ley lines, and a holy well known for its curative properties. Look out for fairies at Madron Cairn, before visiting King Arthur country. A castle set high on the rugged coast on one of the most dramatic sites in the whole of Britain, the cave where Arthur endured his training with Merlyn, and see the world's largest collection of witchcraft related artefacts. Dine in Cornwall's most famous smuggling inn, a yoga session and meditation can all be included.
